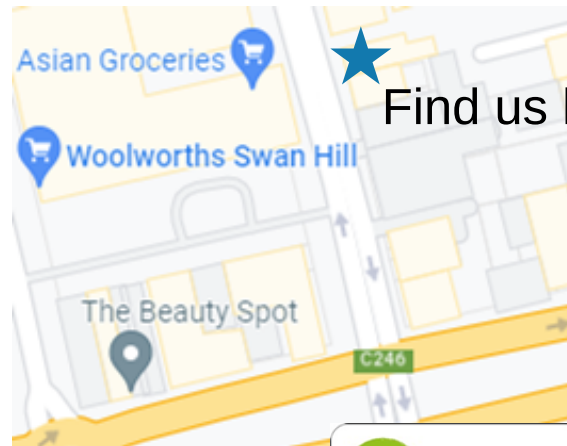

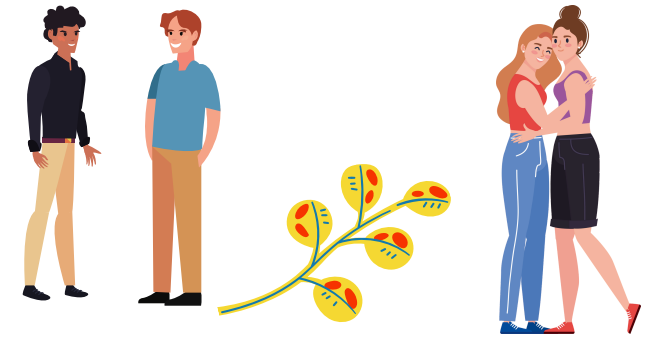

The following services are free, no referral needed:

- Oral contraceptive prescriptions, advice and counselling
- Long-Acting Reversible Contraception (LARC) insertion/removal/change over
- Long-Acting Contraception- Contraceptive Injection
- Emergency contraception prescribing and administering
- Prescribing and assisting with medication management
- Cervical screening
- Unplanned pregnancy options including termination of pregnancy
- Diagnostic investigations- pathology, radiology and ultrasound referrals
